We value the love and support of our school families, and we desire to establish and maintain a good relationship with them. No two people will agree on everything. No organization is perfect, no matter how sincere the leadership. Still, there must be a basic unity of direction and a strong mutual trust for people to work together in a task as vital as the training of children.

This agreement form addresses some areas that are important in maintaining that unity and trust.

Please read carefully. If you feel you cannot sign this agreement with a supportive spirit, please contact Mr. Scott Grass so your concerns can be addressed.

In enrolling or returning my child(ren) to Faith Christian for the _____ school year, I (we) understand the following:

1. We are accepting the challenge to help "bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord," and we state that this training will be carried on in the home. We place our trust in FCS to assist us in that training.
2. We will show sincere Christian purpose by faithful, regular attendance of ourselves (at least one parent) and our children to a Bible-believing church.
3. We will support the school by faithfully praying for its program and staff and will support the procedures and disciplinary actions of the school in fact and in spirit.
4. We will attempt to promote the spirit of unity within the ministry of the school by following the Matthew 18 principle. We agree that if we have a problem related to the school, we will always first contact the person involved in the problem at school (rather than those not concerned) who can best help. Then if necessary, we will continue up the proper chain of command until our problem is remedied.
5. We will speak of the school in the best light possible, even when we disagree on a particular policy or action. We will assume that the school means well, having as its goal the glory of God and the good of the students. If we no longer sincerely hold this assumption, we will transfer our children, but we will not tear down the school in the eyes of others.
6. We are vesting authority in the school to discipline our child as necessary. We further agree that we will cooperate and discipline our child as needed in the home (Proverbs 13:24, 19:18, 23:13-14, 29:15, 17; Colossians 3:20; Hebrews 12:6).
7. Faith Christian School's mission is to partner effectively with parents to equip students to live effectively in God's world. Of necessity, this involves the school's understanding and belief of what qualities or characteristics exemplify a Christ-like life. We believe that the Scriptures of the Old Testament and New Testament are verbally inspired by God and inerrant in the original writing and that they are supreme, sufficient and final authority in faith and life. The ultimate basis for the rules, principles and practices of Faith Christian School is the Bible – God's Holy Word. Faith Christian School forms a partnership with the home and family to help educate students and to guide them in biblical character and

development. Because the school adheres to the Bible, the standards of conduct specified in the Bible in many areas (ex: morality, integrity, sexuality, relationships, etc.) are standards of conduct for FCS regardless of whether there is a separate FCS policy in place.

8. We are pledging that if, for any reason, our child does not respond favorably to the school, we will not try to change the school to fit him but will confer with the school authorities, and if necessary, we will quietly withdraw him.
9. We understand that our child will go on scheduled field trips and other school activities unless excused by the school authorities.
10. We are agreeing to pay all tuition and fees according to agreements and to conclude all required payments on or before the last day of school. If payments cannot be made when due, we will contact the school office to make arrangements. We understand that if tuition payments get behind, our child may not be able to continue in school and that report cards and records will be withheld at the end of the school year if required payments are not made in full.
11. We are acknowledging that we have read this Family Cooperation Agreement and the Morality, Sexual Activity and Student Pregnancy Policy, and we will uphold them both in fact and spirit.

MORALITY, SEXUAL ACTIVITY AND STUDENT PREGNANCY *(excerpt from Parent/Student Handbook, p. 28)*

Faith Christian School's mission is to partner effectively with parents in preparing students to live effectively in God's world. Of necessity, this involves the school's understanding and belief of what qualities or characteristics exemplify a Christ-like life. We believe the Scriptures of the Old Testament and New Testament are verbally inspired by God and inerrant in the original writing, and that they are of supreme, sufficient, and final authority in faith and life. The ultimate authority and basis for the rules, principles and practices of Faith Christian School is the Bible – God's holy Word. Faith Christian School forms a partnership with the home and family to help educate students and to guide them in biblical character and development. Because the School adheres to the Bible, the standards of conduct specified in the Bible in many areas, e.g. morality, integrity, sexuality, relationships, etc., are standards of conduct for FCS regardless of whether there is a separate FCS policy in place.

One of the most enjoyable gifts that the Lord gives us is relationships shared among believers, and this is especially true of the relationship shared between members of the opposite sex. It is part of God's plan that young people have the potential to meet, date, and possibly eventually marry someone from the opposite sex. For members of the opposite sex to enjoy each other's company and companionship is not only good, but also it is part of God's sovereign design. FCS is a school for students who are unmarried and who live at home with their parent(s) and/or legal guardian(s). FCS upholds a traditional Biblical view of sexual morality (1 Thessalonians 4:3-5). Students shall not engage in sexually promiscuous behavior (e.g., premarital sexual intercourse, oral sex, exhibition of nudity to those of the opposite sex, sexting, petting or caressing the private parts of another, homosexuality, etc.) on or off campus.

Even though parents may personally believe differently, while enrolled at FCS, all students are expected to exhibit the qualities espoused by the school and to refrain from certain activities or behavior. Violation of this policy will result in discipline which may include probation, suspension, being asked to withdraw from school, being expelled from school, or other consequences determined by the FCS administration.

In the event of a resulting pregnancy, we will work with the student(s) and the students' parents to determine the most appropriate manner for continuing their education. Great care will be taken to acknowledge the continued spiritual and educational needs of the students involved, while maintaining a healthy school environment for the remaining student body. This decision will be at the discretion of school administration.

5. I will maintain an attitude of purity and self-control in my personal life.
6. I will respect those in authority and my peers.
7. I will give God praise and glory for all that He does and is.
